- What:** OBB is a part of the Ohio Department of Health’s child passenger safety program. It provides child safety seats and booster seats to eligible low income families in Warren County. The goal is to increase the availability of child safety seats for families who could not otherwise afford them. The site coordinator is also a certified CPS technician who conducts education/installation sessions with the parents/caregivers. The coordinator also provides up-to-date information about Ohio’s Child Restraint Law.
- Who:** In order to receive an OBB seat a parent/caregiver must be within WIC income guidelines, although recipient does not need to be enrolled in WIC to receive a seat. Family must have a child who is within the age/weight/height requirements for a car/booster seat and must attend an educational class.
- When:** An appointment is needed since parent/caregiver must attend a short educational session provided by the site coordinator. In this session, the parent/caregiver receives important education on how to properly use the car/booster seat and how to correctly install it in their vehicle.
